## Music Education Teaching

**Stop the Hate Youth Sing Out** a five-session songwriting workshop for 6th-12th grade students in schools throughout the Greater Cleveland and Northeast Ohio region as funding permits. The workshop will assist students in writing an original song. During the fifth session each class will record their song to be entered into a contest, where the winning school receives a grant prize.

**Blues is the Backbone** is an age-appropriate, cross curricular education program offered for kindergarten and second grade students reinforcing language arts, music, and social emotional learning standards. Through the exploration of blues musicians, history, and culture, the students will improve literacy skills, enhance music skills, and gain confidence through social emotional learning. *Blues is the Backbone* culminates with students writing lyrics to their own class song. *The program is offered for* nine, weekly in-class sessions during the classroom teacher's specified class time.
