Independence Village of Avon Lake is a vibrant community offering memory care, assisted living, and independent living options across its 190 apartments. Under the guidance of Life Enrichment Director Cheryl Brammer, the village is known for its dynamic environment and the special moments created for its residents. With a diverse range of mobility and care needs, Cheryl and her team tailor events to ensure everyone feels included and engaged.

Independence Village hosts Roots of American Music programming twice-monthly during Happy Hour on Fridays. These events typically feature a solo performer, who performs in the memory care neighborhood before moving to the atrium in the independent living area. The music is a delightful mix featuring either guitar or piano, often accompanied by singing that encourages residents to join in.

"We recently had a new artist, Chris Hatton, in to perform," explains Brammer. "He struck just the right chord with the residents. There was a joy and energy in the room that was lovely to see. He had everyone dancing and singing along."

Brammer says that ROOTS staff has made the booking process simple and engaging. "(ROOTS Education Program Director) Bettyjeane Quimby visited the location to understand the layout and performance space," she says. "Also, Bettyjeane has incorporated an app which provides a list of musicians and facilitates communication for booking and other needs."

Not only that, but ROOTS provides the Senior Center Performance feedback form, which helps the village gather and share feedback and concerns, ensuring that the programming continues to meet the residents' expectations.

Independence Village of Avon Lake remains a beacon of community spirit, where every resident is valued and supported. Through innovative programming and a commitment to creating special moments, the village continues to thrive, offering a welcoming home to all its residents.





The 2024-25 school year has again featured ROOTS music education program, *Blues is the Backbone* with 32 classes in 12 elementary schools.
